I. INTRODUCTION

POCL 568 Issue 3 mandates the requirements for listing go/no go criteria used in determining the fitness to run of freight rolling stock in service. This is known as 'The Registered List' and is identified within the Freight Technical Committee (FTC) Business Standard FTC/BS/002, Issue 2, 'In - Service Examination and Reference Limits for Freight Rolling Stock - The Registered List'.

2. INSTRUCTION

The requirements relative to this POCL (i.e. the go/no go criteria) are all contained within FTC/BS/002, Issue 2.

The go/no go criteria included in 'The Registered List' is provided to Owners to advise them of the criteria used by the Freight Operating Companies (FOCs) in determining the fitness to run of rolling stock, when operated on Network Rail managed infrastructure.

3. SCOPE

This POCL applies to all PWRA registered rolling stock that operates on Network Rail managed infrastructure.
