I. INTRODUCTION

POCL 647, Issue I, details a one-off safety inspection of all screw couplings manufactured by Brockhouse Group Limited between September 2005 and October 2008. The need for such an inspection arises from the issue of NIR 2468 following the discovery of a crack in a localised depression on the shackle of a screw coupling during routine visual inspection and the subsequent publication of a safety bulletin by Brockhouse Group Limited.

2. BACKGROUND

Brockhouse Group Limited has recommended that all screw couplings manufactured by them between September 2005 and October 2008 are inspected for cracks. The couplings involved are stamped with Brockhouse Group Limited assembly references CC-36 to CC-73, which is located on the screw/handle part of each assembly. A list of all the relevant screw couplings (including the associated rail catalogue numbers and drawing references manufactured by Brockhouse Group Limited during the specified period) is included as Table 1, to assist Owners in identifying the couplings requiring inspection.

3. INSTRUCTION

At the next weekly maintenance event carry out a careful, one-off visual inspection of the shackles of all relevant screw couplings. Any screw coupling found with localised depressions, cracks or other surface breaking defects shall be withdrawn from service and quarantined.

4. SCOPE

This instruction applies to all screw couplings manufactured by Brockhouse Group Limited between September 2005 and October 2008.

5. IMPLEMENTATION

This document shall be implemented immediately.
